- 1. <u>AMENDMENTS</u>. For and in consideration of mutual promises and/or their valuable consideration, all provisions of the original contract, as amended, dated <u>April 20, 2011</u> attached hereto as Exhibit A, remain in full force and effect with the exception of the following:
 - A. This is the fourth amendment to the original contract, which provides access to an 800 Mhz two-way radio system in support of the Gaming Control Board's Enforcement Division field operations in Southern Nevada. This amendment extends the termination date from December 31, 2014 to June 30, 2015 due to the continued need for these services.

Current Contract Language:

- 3. <u>CONTRACT TERM</u>. This Contract shall be effective from <u>April 18, 2011</u>, to <u>December 31, 2014</u>, unless sooner terminated by either party as specified in paragraph ten (10).
- 6. CONSIDERATION. The parties agree that Contractor will provide the services specified in paragraph five (5) at a cost of \$1,460.00 per radio the State places in service with SNACC system, and additionally the State will pay an annual user fee of \$185.00 per radio per year or partial year said radio is used on the SNACC system for the period April 11, 2011 through June 30, 2014, and a semi-annual fee of \$100.00 per radio for the period July 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014 (state the exact cost or hourly, daily, or weekly rate exclusive of travel or per diem expenses) with the total Contract or installments payable: upon activation for each radio activated and annually thereafter for each radio used on the SNACC system, for the period April 11, 2011 through June 30, 2014, and semi-annually for the period July 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014, upon receipt of state approved invoice, not to exceed \$35,000.00. The State does not agree to reimburse Contractor for expenses unless otherwise specified in the incorporated attachments. Any intervening end to a biennial appropriation period shall be deemed an automatic renewal (not changing the overall Contract term) or a termination as the results of legislative appropriation may require.

Amended Contract Language:

3. <u>CONTRACT TERM</u>. This Contract shall be effective from <u>April 18, 2011</u>, to <u>June 30, 2015</u>, unless sooner terminated by either party as specified in paragraph ten (10).

- 6. CONSIDERATION. The parties agree that Contractor will provide the services specified in paragraph five (5) at a cost of \$1.460.00 per radio the State places in service with SNACC system, and additionally the State will pay an annual user fee of \$185.00 per radio per year or partial year said radio is used on the SNACC system for the period April 11, 2011 through June 30, 2014, and a semi-annual fee of \$100.00 per radio for the periods July 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014, and January 1, 2015 through June 30, 2015 (state the exact cost or hourly, daily, or weekly rate exclusive of travel or per diem expenses) with the total Contract or installments payable: upon activation for each radio activated and annually thereafter for each radio used on the SNACC system, for the period April 11, 2011 through June 30, 2014, and semi-annually for the period July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015, upon receipt of state approved invoice, not to exceed \$35,000.00. The State does not agree to reimburse Contractor for expenses unless otherwise specified in the incorporated attachments. Any intervening end to a biennial appropriation period shall be deemed an automatic renewal (not changing the overall Contract term) or a termination as the results of legislative appropriation may require.
- 2. <u>INCORPORATED DOCUMENTS</u>. Exhibit A (Original Contract, as amended) is attached hereto, incorporated by reference herein and made a part of this amended contract.
- 3. <u>REQUIRED APPROVAL</u>. This amendment to the original contract shall not become effective until and unless approved by the Nevada State Board of Examiners.






Detailed Busies - Monthly Report
