#### 4. Approve the SNACC Budget for Fiscal Year 2016-2017. (FOR POSSIBLE ACTION)

- Administrator Goss presented a power point of the SNACC Budget. (Available upon request)
- Teri McGeachy stated that the steadily increasing fund balance will continue to increase with the radio yearly fee increasing 5.7% every year.
- Jeff Lytle suggested that all users should receive a letter with the increase of the yearly fee so that the users have this before they start working on their fiscal year budgets.
- Administrator Goss wanted to give Teri McGeachy of Clark County Finance credit for her work on this report.

#### 5. Review the draft of the SNACC Strategic Plan. (FOR DISCUSSON)

- Jeff Buchanan commented that his idea on the Strategic Plan was to just bring some ideas to the board and see if this was the right direction.
- Dane Mattoon commented that this was an item that would be worked on further with the Operations Governance Working Group (OGWOG).
- Jeff Buchanan changed some verbiage, added performance measurements, and baseline. He wanted to follow the previous format and flowed through the draft.
- Jeff Buchanan asked Administrator Goss if there were SOP's. Administrator Goss then answered that there aren't any current SOP's.
- Jeff Lytle mentioned that the SNACC Bylaws are what can be used instead of the SOP's.
- Jeff Buchanan said the main focus was to bring short term and long term goals and wanted to know if this mirrors what SNACC wants to achieve.
- Dane Mattoon commended Jeff Buchanan on his work on the draft presented and wanted to bring this to the Board so that there would be an idea on what the OGWOG is working on.
- Jeff Buchanan stated that the group needs to come up with more ideas for developing a COOP with goals, customer service feedback, and emergency plan. Administrator Goss stated that he has begun to work on getting an Emergency Plan together.

#### **COMMENTS BY THE GENERAL PUBLIC:**

• Chris Vasquez from North Las Vegas stated that the U.S. Marshals service requested to have some North Las Vegas channels in their radios and says they work with some of their SWAT and Henderson's SWAT. Chris suggested giving them like a test run with ID's and they were told that the U.S. Marshals have Metro's key. Administrator Goss says he doesn't feel comfortable giving out system keys out. Lou Amell agrees that if there are keys being given to more than one then the system will get over flowed.






