

### Call to Order

Public Comment: NONE GIVEN

1. Approve the May 25, 2023 agenda and the minutes from the February 15, 2023 meeting. (*FOR POSSIBLE ACTION*)
  - Motion was made to approve; motion passed unanimously.
2. Receive the Administrator's report with the inclusion of the SNACC monthly financial reports and budget variances for the months of February, March, and April 2023 and system reports for the months of February, March, and April of 2023. (*FOR DISCUSSION*):

SNACC ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT May 25, 2023 SNACC UPDATES: On Friday February 24th SNACC had a power outage at Arden Peak that caused multiple site to go into site trunking and caused some dispatch centers to use their backup connectivity. What lead up to this was both SNACC and NV Energy not realizing that there was a power outage that started earlier in the week. SNACC was able to identify why we did not receive our alarm that we were

on generator power and corrected it. This issue was also addressed with NV Energy and we are continuing to work with them. City of Henderson has replaced their X series radios. The Department of Aviation has replaced their X series radios and has also purchased the upgrades to those APX series radios to make them TDMA compatible. In February we received the quote to replace the grounding of the site that was mentioned in the last SNACC Board meeting. This will cost \$5,542 to replace. We are currently waiting for these materials to arrive. SNACC has currently received 29 pallets of equipment for Aviat for our microwave upgrade project. The last of the equipment should be shipping sometime in July. The MPLS routers for the microwave project should be shipping sometime in August. The old Dodge Ram truck which was replaced by the new Ford F250 truck was sold at auction. SNACC received \$27,075 for the Dodge Ram. The cost of the new truck we received early this year was \$47,426.30.

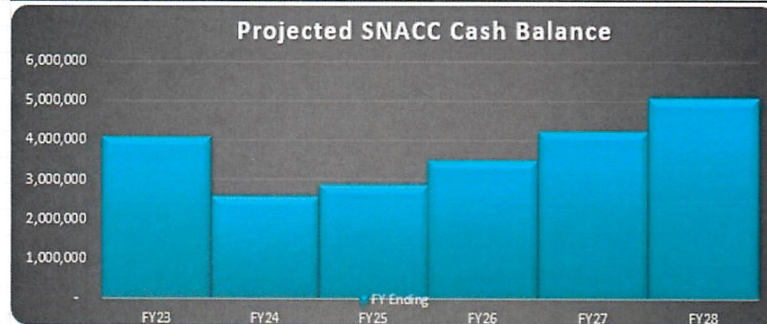

  - Simulcast Redesign Project – This allows SNACC to expand and align our current radio coverage in the Las Vegas Valley to keep pace with the current growth trend.
  - NCORE Replacement Radios: There are ten radios that are tied into the statewide NCORE interoperability communications. The current radios are old and will not support TDMA.



# SNACC ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

**June 7, 2023**

**Presented By Jason Manzo**

We are continuing to work with the City of Henderson and Clark County Department of Aviation with their migration from their XTS/XTL radios to their new APX radios.

We are waiting for the last of the Microwave equipment to ship. We have been told it should be shipping in July 2023.

We are waiting for the materials to arrive to replace the grounding wires that were stolen from one of our sites.

A reminder email regarding TDMA was sent out to all users on May 25, 2023, by Daniela Soto. This letter was originally sent out on July 6, 2022, which says as follows:

*July 6, 2022*

*Greetings SNACC Customers,*

*The Southern Nevada Area Communications Council ("SNACC") Board of Directors has voted to have the SNACC radios on the system upgraded to be Time Division Multiple Access ("TDMA") ready by June 30, 2024. This is a reminder to make sure your agency radios are TDMA ready (Feature installed and/or programmed into all radios) by this date.*

*Please do not hesitate to contact SNACC if your organization needs guidance on how to upgrade your radios, replace radios to be TDMA compliant by this date, or to start discussions for a potential alternative plan.*

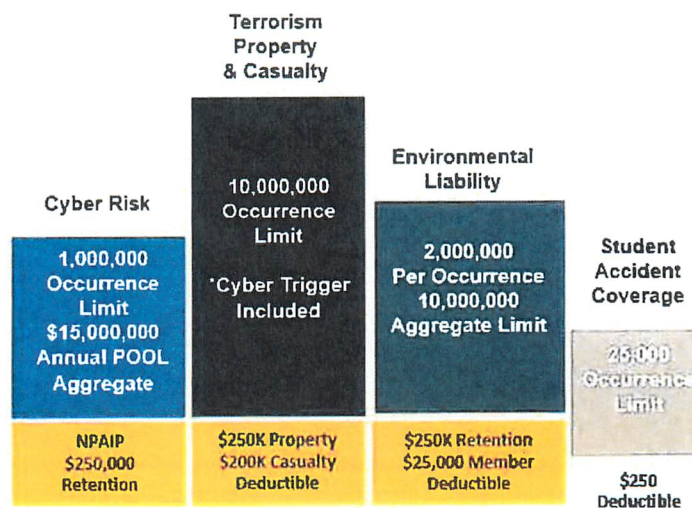

3. **CONTRACT TERM.** This Contract shall be effective as noted below, unless sooner terminated by either party as specified in *Section 4, Termination*.

To: June 30, 2025

4. **TERMINATION.** This Contract may be terminated by either party prior to the date set forth in *Section 3, Contract Term*, provided that a termination shall not be effective until 30 days after a party has served written notice upon the other party. This Contract may be terminated by mutual consent of both parties or unilaterally by either party without cause. The parties expressly agree that this Contract shall be terminated immediately if for any reason State and/or federal funding ability to satisfy this Contract is withdrawn, limited, or impaired.
5. **NOTICE.** All communications, including notices, required or permitted to be given under this Contract shall be in writing and directed to the parties at the addresses stated above. Notices may be given: (a) by delivery in person; (b) by a nationally recognized next day courier service, return receipt requested; or (c) by certified mail, return receipt requested. 7. **CONSIDERATION.** The parties agree that the services specified in *Section 6, Incorporated Documents* at a cost as noted below:

SNACC agrees to provide the services set forth in paragraph (6) at a cost of \$27,009.98 for FY 2024 and \$28,549.12 for FY 2025 for the existing 82 radios, plus the applicable service fee and buy-in fee for any additional radios the state may put into service.

Total Contract or installments payable at: Upon receipt of state-approved invoice

Total Contract Not to Exceed: \$59,999.00

Any intervening end to a biennial appropriation period shall be deemed an automatic renewal (not changing the overall Contract term) or a termination as the result of legislative appropriation may require.

8. **ASSENT.** The parties agree that the terms and conditions listed in the incorporated Attachments of this Contract are also specifically a part of this Contract and are limited only by their respective order of precedence and any limitations expressly provided.

9. **INSPECTION & AUDIT**

- A. **Books and Records.** Each party agrees to keep and maintain under general accepted accounting principles full, true and complete records, agreements, books, and document as are necessary to fully disclose to the State or United States Government, or their authorized representatives, upon audits or reviews, sufficient information to determine compliance with all State and federal regulations and statutes.

- B. **Inspection & Audit.** Each party agrees that the relevant books, records (written, electronic, computer related or otherwise), including but not limited to relevant accounting procedures and practices of the party, financial statements and supporting documentation, and documentation related to the work product shall be subject, at any reasonable time, to inspection, examination, review, audit, and copying at any office or location where such records may be found, with or without notice by the State Auditor, Employment Security, the Department of Administration, Budget Division, the Nevada State Attorney General's Office or its Fraud Control Units, the State Legislative Auditor, and with regard to any federal funding, the relevant federal agency, the Comptroller General, the General Accounting Office, the Office of the Inspector General, or any of their authorized representatives.
- C. **Period of Retention.** All books, records, reports, and statements relevant to this Contract must be retained a minimum three years and for five years if any federal funds are used in this Contract. The retention period runs from the date of termination of this Contract. Retention time shall be extended when an audit is scheduled or in progress for a period reasonably necessary to complete an audit and/or to complete any administrative and judicial litigation which may ensue.
10. **BREACH - REMEDIES.** Failure of either party to perform any obligation of this Contract shall be deemed a breach. Except as otherwise provided for by law or this Contract, the rights and remedies of the parties shall not be exclusive and are in addition to any other rights and remedies provided by law or equity, including but not limited to actual damages, and to a prevailing party reasonable attorneys' fees and costs. It is specifically agreed that reasonable attorneys' fees shall not exceed \$150.00 per hour.
11. **LIMITED LIABILITY.** The parties will not waive and intend to assert available NRS Chapter 41 liability limitations in all cases. Contract liability of both parties shall not be subject to punitive damages. Actual damages for any State breach shall never exceed the amount of funds which have been appropriated for payment under this Contract, but not yet paid, for the fiscal year budget in existence at the time of the breach.
12. **FORCE MAJEURE.** Neither party shall be deemed to be in violation of this Contract if it is prevented from performing any of its obligations hereunder due to strikes, failure of public transportation, civil or military authority, acts of public enemy, acts of terrorism, accidents, fires, explosions, or acts of God, including, without limitation, earthquakes, floods, winds, or storms. In such an event the intervening cause must not be through the fault of the party asserting such an excuse, and the excused party is obligated to promptly perform in accordance with the terms of the Contract after the intervening cause ceases.
13. **INDEMNIFICATION.** Neither party waives any right or defense to indemnification that may exist in law or equity.
14. **INDEPENDENT PUBLIC AGENCIES.** The parties are associated with each other only for the purposes and to the extent set forth in this Contract, and in respect to performance of services pursuant to this Contract, each party is and shall be a public agency separate and distinct from the other party and, subject only to the terms of this Contract, shall have the sole right to supervise, manage, operate, control, and direct performance of the details incident to its duties under this Contract. Nothing contained in this Contract shall be deemed or construed to create a partnership or joint venture, to create relationships of an employer-employee or principal-agent, or to otherwise create any liability for one agency whatsoever with respect to the indebtedness, liabilities, and obligations of the other agency or any other party.
15. **WAIVER OF BREACH.** Failure to declare a breach or the actual waiver of any particular breach of the Contract or its material or nonmaterial terms by either party shall not operate as a waiver by such party of any of its rights or remedies as to any other breach.
16. **SEVERABILITY.** If any provision contained in this Contract is held to be unenforceable by a court of law or equity, this Contract shall be construed as if such provision did not exist and the non-enforceability of such provision shall not be held to render any other provision or provisions of this Contract unenforceable.



SCOPE OF WORK

1. The Southern Nevada Area Communications Council ("SNACC") agrees to grant access to its two-way radio communications system to the State Gaming Control Board ("SGCB") for the use of SGCB-owned 800 MHz radios compatible with the SNACC system.
2. The SGCB will be responsible for the purchase, installation, and maintenance of all radios it uses on the SNACC system.
3. SNACC will provide programming and other services so that the SGCB radios will be able to operate on the SNACC system. SNACC does not warrant that radios purchased by the SGCB are compatible with the SNACC system. The SGCB is solely responsible for providing radios compatible with SNACC system operational requirements.
4. SNACC will annually review SGCB use of the SNACC system and notify the SGCB whether the system has sufficient capacity to continue support of SGCB use.
5. SNACC does not warrant that radio transmission or reception coverage will be available at all points in the Las Vegas Valley or outside of the Las Vegas Valley. The SGCB is solely responsible for testing coverage in all areas it intends to use radios in conjunction with the SNACC system.
